TREX is a two-week program that includes volunteer and adventure excursions off property. This is a great opportunity for our oldest Day Camp campers to develop leadership skill, personal growth and have a blast!



Camp Wright is licensed and inspected by the State of Maryland and local Fire Marshal. A licensed nurse, EMT, or physician is on site 24 hours a day during overnight camp. Local physicians and hospitals are available for urgent medical care. All program staff are certified in First Aid, AED, and CPR. Camp Wright is a tech-free camp and camper cell phones will not be permitted. Campers are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that is conducive to our programming, mission, and goals,. Behavior that is deemed dangerous, inappropriate, or unmanageable by the Administrative Staff is grounds for dismissal from camp. Parents will be contacted as needed.
