For campers who have completed grades 3-6.



Campers will enjoy days at the barn grooming, tacking, and riding horses with our friends at Talisman Therapeutic Riding Inc. Campers are dropped off at Camp Wright in the morning and head to Talisman Farm from 9:30-1:30pm. Talisman's staff provide an array of experiences including care of horses and riding instruction; CW staff accompany campers to the barn to provide supervision and support. Back at camp, there will be time for swimming, crafts and other traditional CW fun. Transportation is provided to and from Talisman in our insured vehicles with certified drivers.

# TREX

For campers who have completed 7-9th grade

**\$450 a session**

(Includes transportation to and from excursions and the overnight stay at CW)

Trex is a two-week long program that includes volunteer and adventure excursions off property. This is a great opportunity for our oldest Day campers to develop leadership skills and individual growth while having a blast! Days spent at camp will involve traditional camp activities like swimming, boating, and outdoor living skills as well as small group discussions. Trex campers will also participate in an overnight stay at Camp Wright.

## Camper Health, Safety and Behavior

Camp Wright is licensed and inspected by the State of Maryland and local Fire Marshal. The kitchen and pool areas are inspected and licensed by the Queen Anne's County Health Department. A licensed nurse, EMT or physician is on site 24 hours a day during overnight camp. Local physicians and hospitals are available for urgent medical care. All program staff are certified in First Aid, AED and CPR. Campers are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that is conducive to our programming, mission and goals. Behavior that is deemed dangerous, inappropriate, or unmanageable by the Administrative Staff is grounds for dismissal from camp. Parents will be contacted as needed.
